Under the ownership of well-known Bordeaux negociants the Sichel family since 1961, Angludet translates to 'Angel of the High Land'. Surrounded as it is by all Grand Cru Classé properties, Château Angludet would almost certainly have been included in the 1855 Classification, had the property not been broken up as part of an inheritance settlement. In an act of faith (given the property's state of decay) and belief in Angludet's potential, the Sichel family bought the estate in 1961. Since then, the Sichels have worked tirelessly to restore and improve the vineyard and cellars, giving Angludet back the reputation its exceptional terroir deserves. The wines now enjoy a worldwide reputation for their elegance, aromatic finesse and their exceptional ageing potential. The 2011 is delicious, ripe and rich with a wonderful pure, bright and crunchy core of red berries that really leaves you wanting more - a wine that you could easily fall in love with.

#### Château Angludet, Margaux

Château Angludet, Margaux

Another truly exceptional wine from the Sichel family, the 2012 dAngludet has a deep ruby/purple color, a sweet floral, blueberry and blackcurrant-scented nose with a touch of licorice, light tannins, low acidity and a nice, fleshy mouthfeel. This is a sexy, mouth-filling and satisfying wine from both a hedonistic and intellectual vantage point.

#### Château Haut-Bergey, Pessac-Léognan

Pessac-Léognan is a sub-region of Graves, the famous area just south of the town of Bordeaux itself. Dating back to the 14th century, Haut Bergey was an under-achiever until bought by Sylviane Garcin-Cathiard in 1991. Her daughter Helene now runs the estate with husband Patrice Leveque, along with Clos L'Eglise (Pomerol, just 6 hectares), Branon (Pessac-Léognan), Barde-Haut (Saint Emilion Grand Cru), and, last but not least, Poesia, in Mendoza, Argentina. The estate has been extensively renovated and the construction of three new chais were carried out to rehabilitate the domain. The 29 ha of Haut Bergey are not all in production, 21 ha are planted with 65% Cabernet Sauvignon and 35% Merlot while 3 ha are planted with 65% Sauvignon Blanc and 35% Semillon. The 2010 exhibits blackberry, gravel, coffee, liquorice, smoke and earthy aromatics in abundance. With easy to like textures, this medium bodied Pessac Leognan ends with a spicy, black cherry finish.

#### Château Larrivet, Haut-Brion, Pessac-Léognan 2014

Château Larrivet Haut-Brion is located a mere 15km south-east of Bordeaux and has been consistently impressive since its excellent 1996. General manager, Philippe Gervoson, has enlisted the help of the legendary oenologist Michel Rolland who has implemented radical changes such as hand-picking the grapes as late as possible to ensure maximum ripeness. Rolland's great skill is to help make wines that are true representations of their commune, and these are fine examples.

Château Haut-Bailly is a Graves Cru Classé estate that has really hit form in the last 18 years. Haut-Bailly was bought by the Sanders family in 1955 and was run by Jean Sanders until 1998 when Robert G. Wilmers, an American banker, purchased it. It is located in the commune of Léognan, which is usually more associated with white wine production. This second wine of the Estate is attractive, soft and round with notes of berry fruit and some underlying smoke, forest floor and underbrush, it is generously endowed but at the same time elegant and silky smooth. A guintessential example of pure finesse, elegance, harmony and delicacy is combined into a wine that lingers intensely with near-perfect poise and character. Haut-Bailly's ethereal character is virtually unmatched in Bordeaux.

Viticulture can be traced as far back as the reign of Henry II on Château Brown's 59ha estate in Pessac Leognan, south of the city of Bordeaux. Since 1795, the property has been known under the name of Brown, John Lewis - a Scots wine trader who also had a hand in establishing the greater known Château Cantenac-Brown in Margaux. Château Brown was bought in 2004 by the Mau family, together with a Dutch businessman, Cees Dirkzwager. Whilst Château Brown white wines are among the best of great whites from Bordeaux—the Reds have also been recognised as one of the top wines from the relatively new appellation Pessac-Léognan which was created in 1987 by André Lurton, the head of one of Bordeaux's most influential families.

#### Château Talbot, Saint-Julien

2010 £115.00 because it takes its name from John Talbot, 1st Earl of Shrewsbury, who in 1453 suffered the ignominy of losing the Battle of Castillon (The Hundred Years War), and with it his life, which allowed Bordeaux and its vineyards to slip back into French control after belonging to the British Crown for over 340 years. This class growth owes its first-rate reputation to the particularly charming character of its wine. Unfailingly consistent, Talbot embodies with elegance all the complexity of its terroir. Its firm, well-rounded tannins offer a smoothness ever present over the years. Being highly concentrated, it can be left to age for many years even though it is tempting to drink it young to enjoy the fullness of its fruity aromas and silken finish.

#### Château Branaire-Ducru, Saint-Julien

Situated on the opposite side of the road from Beychevelle in the south of the St-Julien appellation. Patrick Maroteaux has owned the property since 1988 & has invested heavily in new plantings as well as installing a new cuvier and an ultra-modern chai. The proportion of Cabernet Sauvignon in the blend is one of the highest in the Médoc at 80/85%. "A top-notch effort from this estate, the 2011 exhibits an exotic perfume of lead pencil shavings, white chocolate, raspberry jam and red as well as blackcurrants. Loads of fruit, a medium to fullbodied mouthfeel and velvety tannin suggest this beauty will drink well for 15+ years. It is one of the stars of the appellation". - Robert Parker

#### Château Langoa-Barton, Saint-Julien

In 1826, Hugh Barton, already proprietor of Château Langoa, purchased part of the big Léoville estate next door. This became known as Léoville Barton. Six generations of Bartons have since followed, and continued to improve the quality of the wine, classified a 2nd growth in 1855. Ronald Barton inherited the property in 1927. He in turn donated it to his nephew Anthony in 1983. Today the vineyards are jointly owned by Anthony Barton, his daughter Lilian Barton-Sartorius and her children Melanie and Damien, thus making eight generations of Barton family at Léoville Barton.

Château Lynch Bages, a 5ème Cru Classé, is one of the best-known Médoc estates and has always had a particularly strong following on this side of the English Channel. Since 1973 it has been owned by the enigmatic Jean-Michel Cazes and is now run by his son, Jean-Charles. Lynch Bages's vineyards are superbly sited on a plateau west of Pauillac town, in the small village of Bages. The 90ha of vineyards lie on deep gravel beds over limestone. Fermentation is temperature-controlled with extensive 'remontage' to ensure concentration and depth of colour. This is their 2nd wine, which many tasters think is good enough to be a 1st. Generous dark fruits; cedar spice, tobacco leaf and black pepper dominate the complex palate: full-bodied, with velvety tannins and a long finish.

#### Château Le Crock, Cru Bourgeois St-Estèphe

Château Le Crock is one of the finest Cru Bourgeois properties in St. Estèphe, and has been owned by the Cuvelier family since 1903. They also own Léoville Poyferré, as well as a successful négociant business. Le Crock is located south of the village of St. Estèphe, with its 33ha of vines being adjacent to those of Montrose and Cos d'Estournel. Robert Parker - "This is the finest effort I have yet seen from this beautiful chateau, situated on a sweeping hillside with a river, swans, and a Walt Disney-like structure. Le Crock is owned by the Cuvelier family, which has done a great job at Leoville-Poyferre. The 2003 has benefited from being a St.-Estephe, the most consistent appellation of the vintage. Its dense ruby/purple colour is followed by gorgeous aromas of black currants, blackberries, licorice, smoke, and earth. A heady, alcoholic personality, fleshy mouthfeel, medium to full body, and low acidity make for a hedonistic, satisfying, long, concentrated claret."

Château Cos d'Estournel, St-Estèphe

Château Cos d'Estournel is named after its 19C owner, Louis-Gaspard d'Estournel, and it was he who built the bizarre oriental edifice that is a landmark for any tourist in the Médoc. Today Cos d'Estournel is without doubt the leading estate in St-Estéphe. It is located in the south of the appellation on the border with Pauillac and its vineyards are superbly sited on a south-facing gravel ridge with a high clay content, just north of Lafite. "The medium to deep garnet colored 2008 Cos d'Estournel is blended of 85% Cabernet Sauvignon, 13% Merlot and 2% Cabernet Franc. Pow! The nose explodes with notes of baked cherries, preserved plums, fried herbs, beef drippings and warm cassis with wafts of wood smoke, salami and tobacco leaf. Medium-bodied, the palate is elegant and earthy/savory in character, sporting beautifully ripe, grainy tannins and bags of freshness, finishing on a lingering mineral note." Robertparker.com

#### Château Ormes De Pez Jean-Michel Cazes, St-Estèphe

Château Les Ormes de Pez bis one of St-Estèphe's leading Cru Bourgeois properties. It was bought by Jean-Charles Cazes in 1936 and is now owned and run by Jean-Michel Cazes. The latter owns Lynch-Bages! The estate is located just outside the village of Pez in the northern part of the commune. There are 32 hectares of vineyards, which lie on soils rich in gravel on a subsoil of sand and clay. They are planted with 60% Cabernet Sauvignon, 30% Merlot and 10% Cabernet Franc. The grapes are hand-harvested and then fermented in temperature-controlled, stainless steel vats. The wine is then matured in a combination of one and two-year-old barrels from Lynch-Bages. The 2012 Les Ormes de Pez is flashy and seductive. Scents of sweet tobacco, mint, crushed flower, savoury herbs, game, anise and leather meld into a core of dark-fleshed fruit. Some earthiness is already showing in this compact and classic wine, with bright red fruits and deeper cassis showing in tandem. The tannins offer a gentle structure, framing the wine through to a chalky finish.

#### Château Marsau, Cotes de Francs

This excellent little property in the obscure Côtes de Francs is producing delicious wines. Now owned by the president of Bordeaux negociant Dourthe, Jean-Marie Chadronnier, Chateau Marsau has been heralded by Robert Parker as "The Petrus of the Côtes de Francs". Lying at the top of a hill, north-east of the village of Francs, the vineyards benefit from an excellent microclimate, with exceptional sunshine hours. The soils are predominantly clay which suits the Merlot grape variety, with which 85% of the vineyards are planted, very well. The character of the wines is classic right-bank with soft, round, elegant fruit and fabulous balance with the pure ripe tannins in this wine providing a lovely backbone to the ripe blackcurrant and cherry fruit. This region could be one of the next big things in Bordeaux.

#### Château Cantemerle, Haut Médoc

Ch. Cantemerle's woodland setting is amongst the most beautiful of any chateau in the Medoc. It is located in the far south of the region, almost on the outskirts of the city of Bordeaux. It is the first major property on the Medoc Route des Chateaux, north of Bordeaux. With 94ha of vineyards, the wines are made under the guidance of consultant oenologist, Eric Boissenot, undergoing 12 months ageing in French Oak, of which 40% is new. Cantemerle is a Cinquième Cru Classé, with approximately 400,000 bottles produced each year and a further 160,000 bottles of the property's second wine, Les Allées de Cantemerle. Soft and silky on the palate with an almost Right Bank feel this is full if generous, mulberry fruit and supple tannins. The fruit is well balanced by the refreshing acidity, leading to a crisp, clean finish.

#### Château Potensac, Haut Médoc

Château Franc-Maillet Cuvée Jean Baptiste, Pomerol 2009 £53.99

The history of this property starts in 1919 when Jean-Baptiste Arpin returns from World War I and buys a few parcels of vines in Pomerol. For three generations, the Arpins have extended and improved the property. Since 1994, various qualitative improvements were made in the property: de-budding, cover crop, de-leafing, thermoregulation, better control of the vinification and maceration processes. The cuvee "Jean-Baptiste" is produced in collaboration with and is exclusive to Jean-Luc Thunevin. There is a parcel of Merlot within the Franc Maillet vineyard that is planted on a streak of the same red clay that typifies Chateau Petrus just up the road. The 2014 has a compelling bouquet with cranberry, potpourri and light incense aromas and just a hint of bell pepper emanating from the Cabernet Franc. The palate is medium-bodied with firm tannin, superb salinity, fine focus and real precision on the slightly chalky finish.
